

Camp Digalus 2008 Camping Rules

- Every Pack that has registered by 3/2/08 has been assigned a campsite (see separate assignment sheet). We have done our best to accommodate the Packs by size and special needs. Please share this information, your campsite # and the map with everyone in your Pack.
- Campsites will be marked with flags in the corner and a different color flag in the center with the campsite number on it.
- Chalk lines mark the width of the campsite. There are no depth boundaries (except for campsites C1, C2 & C3). Feel free to spread back as deep as necessary.
- We are expecting the turnout to be near our maximum capacity. Be courteous to other packs and share your campsite if necessary.
- Do not block access to any water spigots or restrooms.
- Ramadas are reserved for events and Digalus staff use.
- Camp a comfortable distance from playgrounds and ramadas.
- Every campsite has been placed adjacent to a road or parking lot for easy unloading. Do not park in or block another campsite's unloading zone. You may park in the space adjacent to your campsite when unloading is complete.
- All other vehicles must be parked in the lots marked "overflow parking" as shown on the map.
- Do not drive on the field. The park is trying to protect their irrigation lines.
- Pop-ups are not permitted on the field, but can be parked in your Pack's unloading zone or in the RV lot. Do not park them in the overflow lots, as you will be taking space needed for vehicles.
- All RV's must be parked in the designated RV lot as shown on the map.
- Late registered Packs that have not been assigned a campsite will need to find space in the designated overflow camping area as shown on the map. Keep your campsites to a minimum.
- A portion of the field and certain ramadas have been reserved by other groups and are off-limits. This area is marked as "Keep Out" on the map.
- Paths to enter and exit the Amphitheater will be marked. Do not trail-blaze or cross the caution tape. You may not drive to the Amphitheater. See Digalus Logistics Staff for handicap access (602-377-9813).
- A Scout is Clean! Please leave campsites and restrooms cleaner than you found them.
